RIDGEVIEW CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Our Children's Ministry at Ridgeview is growing and we need your help to keep the momentum going. While we have a core set of teachers and leaders for each activity, as our numbers grow we find a need for helpers and support persons in each area.

Our vision for the Children's Ministry is to develop a pool of people that can share and rotate duties so everyone gets the time off. Our goal is to make sure everyone gets the time they need to participate in worship, attend their own power hour class, and recharge their batteries when needed!

Our children are an integral part of our church. Please consider and pray about the following opportunities to help with this important ministry:

Children's Church: Volunteers help keep children in grades K-5 engaged and focused while they participate in lessons and activities during the sermon segment of worship. Right now we're learning the books of the Bible!

Nursery/Toddlers: Volunteers supervise children ages newborn through 2 (nursery) and ages 3 through 4 (toddler room) during worship. Teachers are also needed to prepare lessons for the toddler room children. We also have a need for volunteers to work with this group on Wednesday nights during Ridgeview Kids, Small Groups and Choir practice.

Power Hour: Teachers are needed for kids in grades K-5 in case the current teachers (who are fabulous!) would like to take a break. Also, it would be wonderful to be able to split this class into two parts (K-2 and 3-5) since kindergarteners and 5th graders don't really like the same things!

Ridgeview Kids: This group is like a youth group for our K-5 kids and meets on Wednesday nights. We have leaders but could use some support. With some extra folks to help keep the kids engaged and focused, we could divide into two age groups, and give our leaders a break once in a while.
